

Fowsa and General Data Protection Regulation

From time to time Fowsa will need to collect your information and process it.

We promise to process your information fairly and lawfully and in accordance with regulations. We will tell you how we use it and why we collect it.

We have appointed a Data Controller who makes sure we act lawfully when processing your information.

Within Fowsa we collect your data in different ways.

Firstly, in the simplest form, when we hold an event i.e Halloween party. We collect data such as names, contact numbers and sometimes medical conditions. This is to ensure your child is kept safe during the event and comply with safeguarding. This type of data is kept only for a short time and destroyed confidentially after the event has taken place.

Secondly, we hold data of the members of our Helping Hand scheme. The information we hold here is name and contact details. We do not ask for any financial information. We require this information as it is a membership scheme and we need it to comply with the rules of the scheme. This information is kept in the Fowsa folder which is stored in a secure office area accessible only by the members of Fowsa. We keep this information for the duration of the time you are a member of the scheme and for a short period afterwards. This is then destroyed confidentially. We do not copy or share this information with any third parties.

Thirdly, we have a closed group Facebook page. By requesting to be a member of this Facebook page you are agreeing that Fowsa can use your data. For example, if you post in the Facebook page, this post is shared with all the members of the Facebook group, even if they are not your 'friend' on Facebook. People are able to view your public profile by clicking on your name, as they would if they searched your name on Facebook. Fowsa are not responsible for this as this is detailed in Facebook's usage policy. You are free to leave the group at any time. Fowsa do not allow any marketing of any kind on their page except for their own events/sales, and posts where items are offered for free.
